Overview of the role:

- Reporting to the National Lead of the NICRF. The post holder will jointly (working directly with the project leads) oversee the implementation of the registry and collaborate on associated research and QI projects.

Responsibilities/duties

Overview

- Team member of the NICRF ICU registry in a new regional intensive care network to improve quality of care and establish a platform for clinical trials in resource-limited settings.
- Facilitate and contribute to Evaluation of ICU performance
- Facilitate and contribute to implementation of locally led quality improvement interventions and clinical trials.

Specific

With support of Project leads and the wider network

- Organize and manage the country and study site coordinators involved in the registry on a day-to-day basis

- Ensure that study specific investigations are undertaken as required by the study protocol and contribute to development of- new/ adapt protocols as necessary to ensure success.
- Contribute data to preparing reports to the funder and other stakeholders
- Ensure ethics/ approvals for projects.
- Contribute to the data collection, data analysis, manuscript writing, and publishing of the output.
- Contribute to accurate document data collection into the case report forms and ensuring that clinical study recruitment records are accurately maintained
- Attend multi-disciplinary meetings, and appropriate clinics, and to act as a resource to the members of the multidisciplinary team
- Contribute scientific input of the analysis and reporting of information gathered during the project
- Ensure scientific output is disseminated to national leads,site level teams in a way that ensures new evidence is available for implementation and improvements in clinical care.
- Facilitate development of a data driven community of practice with the skills to undertake setting specific research and improvement.

Selection criteria

Essential

- Ability to coordinate research projects
- Evidence of continuous professional/academic development, and an established reputation and publication record, preferentially holding a Bachelor's on a relevant topic.
- Experience of working in the field of quality improvement of health care in resource-limited settings
- Experience of working in a clinical research environment and knowledge and research experience in health systems in low- and middle-income countries
- Computer literate in Microsoft Access, Excel, Word
- Excellent written and oral communication skills, evidenced by the ability to explain and interpret procedures clearly and sensitively
- Ability to act on own initiative, but also to contribute as part of a team
